She is = She's

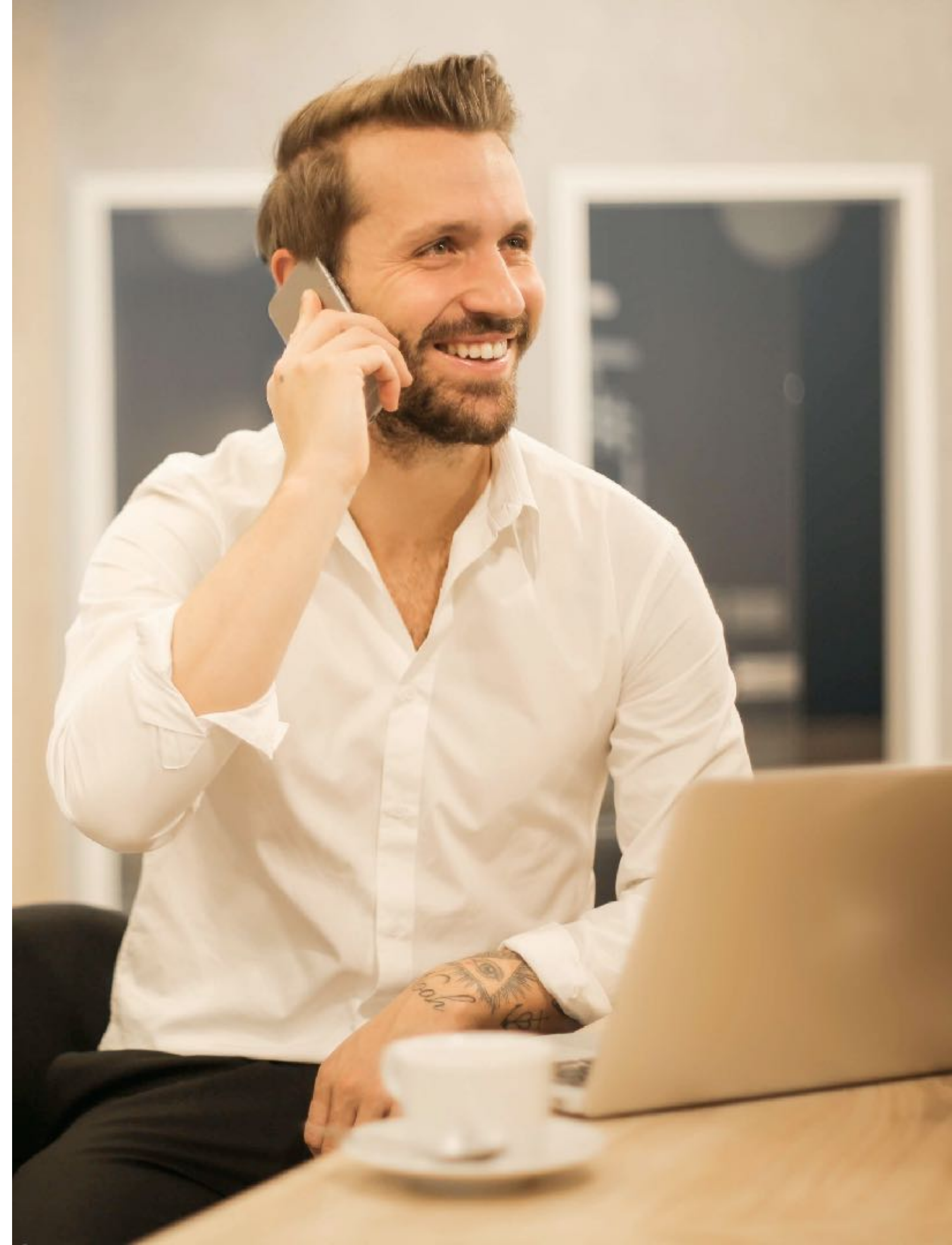
It is = It's
