Grammar - All About Adverbs

- Adverbs are parts of speech that modify verbs, adjectives, clauses and other adverbs.
- Adverbs provide more information about when or how things happen.
- Many adverbs end in -ly, but not all of them do.
- There are 6 main types of adverbs.

1. Conjunctive Adverbs = Connecting

Ex. however, therefore, instead,
meanwhile, etc.

*Jeremy meant to go to work.
Instead, he stayed home and
drank beer.*



2. Adverbs of Frequency = How often

Ex. usually, never, always,
sometimes, constantly, daily, etc.

*They constantly fight over the
stupidest things.*



3. Adverbs of Time = When

Ex. today, yesterday, tomorrow,
eventually, early, yet, recently

*I'll buy a new car eventually, but
not yet.*



4. Adverbs of Manner = How

Ex. loudly, nicely, wisely,
peacefully, angrily, slowly

*The driver shouted angrily at the
man who cut her off.*



5. Adverbs of Degree = How much

Ex. very, really, too, hardly,
somewhat, totally, little, most

*They gave us too little food at the
restaurant and we were
somewhat annoyed.*



6. Adverbs of Place = Where

Ex. here, there, somewhere,
inside, out, away, left, north

*Just turn left at the lights and
you'll be right there.*
